Private Pilot FAA Requirements

Becoming a pilot is a challenging and rewarding endeavor. Many people are reluctant to pursue their pilot's license due to the high cost, but it does not have to be an expensive pursuit.

The Smith Field Flyers is proud to offer the new \$199* Flight Certificate Program.

The program allows a student to complete their flight training in only 8 - 12 months** for just \$199 per month!

The program includes 5 monthly hours of flight time and 10 monthly hours of instruction.



MINIMUM 40 HOURS OF FLIGHT TIME

1. 20 hours dual: must include
 - a. 3 hours cross country training
 - b. 3 hours night; must include
 1. 100 nautical mile total night cross country
 2. 10 takeoff and landings to a full stop/night
 - c. 3 hours of instrument
 - d. 3 hours preparation for the check ride within 60 days
2. 10 hours solo: must include
 - a. 5 hour cross country greater than 50 nautical miles:
 - 1 cross country at least 150 nautical miles total distance with landings at 3 points. One segment must be 50 nautical miles, straight line.
 - b. 3 takeoff and landings at an airport with an operational control tower.
